Graduate Students - Steps to Apply

If you have earned a bachelor's degree, master's degree or other advanced degree you can apply for graduate admission. Explore the options below to find out which application you should choose.

1. **Apply for Graduate Credit** (<https://www.ucmo.edu/future-students/apply-to-ucm/graduate-application-steps/index.php>) Note: **Tuition cost for the (1) Graduate Credit: \$148.50**
2. **Select: Non-Degree Seeking** (<https://giss.admissions.ucmo.edu/apply/?sr=c3da996a-ef8c-4d38-aa3a-c483c6a33bde>)
 - 1) Create an account
 - 2) Select "Special Credit"
 - 3) Select "Professional Development" as your program
 - 4) Submit your application
 - 5) University of Central Missouri will send you an acceptance email
3. Email UCM's CTE Graduate Program to request to be enrolled in **CTE 5000: Guam ACTE**, include these email addresses: mpantleo@ucmo.edu, honomichl@ucmo.edu, bhough@ucmo.edu, and lfischer@ucmo.edu
4. Once enrolled, you will need to complete the assignments per the syllabus provided, and email your summary essay to mpantleo@ucmo.edu by May 1, 2026. Feedback will be sent back to students.
5. Grades and transcripts will be available at the end of UCM's spring semester: May 13, 2026
